

Preamble;

To help maintain and operate the Club, Altona Yacht Club Inc requires the payment of Boat Storage fees for members boats stored at the club's facilities.

Policy Objective;

Boat Storage as an option for members at the Altona Yacht Club is seen as a service to members who choose not to store their boats at their own premises.

Policy Details;

- Annual Storage Fees for the Club are approved at the Annual AGM for the next sailing season.
- Rack Priority will be given to those who sail their stored boat regularly with the Club of Saturday afternoons.
- Storage Fees are due to be paid prior to the start of the sailing season (30<sup>th</sup> September).
- If a new member to the club joins after the 1<sup>st</sup> of January and storage space is available then it is acceptable that the Storage Fee will be halved.
- If a new member to the club joins during the Autumn series and storage space is available then that person will be required to pay the full annual storage fee and will have paid for the remainder of that sailing season plus the next sailing season.

Responsibilities;

- Allocation of a Rack Storage place is the Responsibility of the Club Captain.
- Confirmation of Rack Storage is only completed when payment in full is received by the Club Treasurer or Secretary.
- In genuine cases of hardship the Club Committee shall at its discretion make alternate arrangements with that member.
- The Club Committee reserves the right to remove from the club / relocate to higher Rack spacing any boat that has not paid their Storage Fee by 1<sup>st</sup> November of any given year. This will be done so in accordance with the Club's Boat Storage Agreement.
