

Altona Yacht Club Inc – Boat Lease Agreement

Club Inc training boat _____

I agree to the following terms and conditions of the lease:

- Use of the boat is restricted to Saturday afternoon Club racing.
- The lease requires a refundable \$200 bond to be paid in advance.
- The use of these boats is a privilege and the Altona Yacht Club reserves the right to cancel the lease if the boat is used in an inappropriate manner without refund.
- The boat lease is available for ½ year only and may be extended for a further ½ year at the discretion of the Altona Yacht Club.
- The ½ year lease periods shall be 1st October to 31st December and 1st Jan to End of Autumn series.
- The old club Pacers and club Lasers are available for lease at \$200 / ½ year, a bond of \$200 is payable at the commencement of the lease which will be refunded at the end of the lease term if there is no damage to the boat.
- Recently graduated trainees will have the option of the use of an old club Pacer or a club Laser for ½ year with no lease fee except payment of a bond of \$200 which will be refunded at the end of the lease term if there is no damage to the boat.
- New club Pacers are available to members who have completed at least one ½ year lease with another boat. These are available for lease at \$200 / ½ year, a bond of \$200 is payable at the commencement of the lease which will be refunded at the end of the lease term if there is no damage to the boat.
- A maximum wind speed limit of 15 knots applies to the use of all leased club boats.
- The lessee of a club boat is responsible for washing down the boat, boat fittings and spars & boat trolley with fresh water after each use.
- The lessee of a club boat is responsible for making sure the sails are dry and correctly rolled or folded, as per standard practice for the sail, after each use.
- The lessee is responsible for ensuring the club boat they lease is put away in the appropriate rack position after they have finished using the boat.
- The lessee of a club boat is responsible for immediately reporting any damage to or maintenance requirements for the club boat they have leased to either the Commodore, Training Principal or Club Captain.
- In event of major damage requiring an insurance claim the lessee of the club boat is required to pay the insurance policy excess on the insurance policy claim (\$500).
- Confirmation of the lease is only complete when payment in full is received by the Club Treasurer or Secretary.
